APARTMENT FIRE VICTIM RECEIVES HELP FOR CATS BURNED IN BLAZE FROM HUMANE SOCIETY/SPCA OF BEXAR COUNTY

(San Antonio-TX) The Humane Society/SPCA of Bexar County, on Fredericksburg Rd., was contacted by the Red Cross this afternoon about 4 cats involved in an apartment fire on the Southwest side of San Antonio. Two of the cats in the apartment when the fire took place passed away and the other two are suffering from smoke inhalation and burns. Further details are still unknown.

The Humane Society was asked to help with the two surviving cats that are in dire need of veterinarian assistance. HS Executive Director, Kathryn Bice says, "We are glad to help and provide the special veterinarian care to alleviate these suffering cats. What happened is unfortunate and immediate care is necessary."
