RASH OF STRAYS INJURED BY CARS

UPDATE ON CATS BURNED IN HOUSE FIRE

(San Antonio-TX) The last few days have been very busy for the Humane Society SPCA of Bexar County. A number of dogs and cats have come into the facility with injuries due to vehicles and other accidents. There have been over 5 dogs and cats that have been brought in for emergency care and rehabilitation this week alone. The Humane Society has a Rescue Fund set up to help in cases such as these.

Come out and meet the dogs and get the update on the burned cats today.

Akira- shepherd mix, front leg injury, hit by car, possible amputation

Dodge- Black Mouth Curr, open shoulder injury, broken ribs, hit by car

Lark-lab mix pup, hernia repair, run over by car in driveway

Chevy- lab mix pup, broken pelvis and back leg, found on highway

Cameo- lab mix pup, wound on back caused by possible chemical burn

Michis- Cat burned in house fire, now needing tail removed
