San Antonio Humane Society & Animal Care Services Block Walk to Spay/Neuter Pets for FREE: Saving Lives...Together

(San Antonio-TX January 21, 2012) The San Antonio Humane Society (SAHS) and Animal Care Services (ACS) are kicking off the New Year with a block walk in City Council District 1 to spread the word about free spay/neuter surgeries and vaccinating your pet.

What:

Block walk January 20th & 21st. The January 21st block walk will open with a volunteer rally and press conference, followed by a block walk in District 1.

When:

January 20: 2:30pm volunteer rally, 4-6pm block walk.

January 21: 9:00am volunteer rally, 10:30am Press Conference with block walk to follow.

Where:

All block walkers will assemble at the SAHS, 4804 Fredericksburg Rd. and from there begin the block walk in District 1.

Why:

To inform the community about **free spay & neuter surgeries for pets of residents within the zip codes in Districts 1-4**. The SAHS will conduct the spay/neuter surgeries at their facility with funds from a city grant. Funds are limited, so get your pet in soon! \$10 rabies vaccinations are required for those animals without proof of current vaccination. To see if your pet is eligible, visit sahumane.org to view a list of included zip codes.

Through our partnership with ACS, the SAHS has taken in more than 700 animals from our receiving facility at ACS, keeping dogs and cats out of city kennels and placing them in loving homes. We believe that saving lives together is the best way to make San Antonio a no-kill city.
