**SA, TX** (October 24, 2019) - All cat and kitten adoption fees will be waived this Saturday through Sunday at the San Antonio Humane Society (SAHS) during Sosy's Spook-tacular Adoption Special.

Adopters will go through the same application process and interview as normal. All pet adoptions include spay/neuter surgery, first set of vaccinations, microchip, flea prevention, complimentary wellness exam and more.

The SAHS is located at 4804 Fredericksburg Road just off Northwest Loop 410 and is open every day from noon to 7 p.m.

For those unaware of Sosy's story: she was a beloved pet cat who found her forever home. To honor her memory, her family sponsors feline adoption fees each year at the SAHS to help ensure every cat has the opportunity to find a home, just like she did.
