SAN ANTONIO – Feb. 7, 2020 – Dozens of the San Antonio Humane Society (SAHS) capital campaign supporters attended the Picture the PAWSibilities VIP Donor Preview and Beam signing event of the new Leeu Naylor Medical Building on Feb. 7.

This event showcased the expansion progress of the new medical building that is estimated to provide services for 20,000 pets in our community.

The Leeu Naylor Medical Building will include surgical, orthopedic, and radiology suites, a rehabilitation room, and a medical clinic. In addition to the medical building expansion, the \$10 million Picture the PAWsibilities Capital Campaign also includes renovations to the SAHS Education Building and Cat Pavilion.

SAHS President /CEO Nancy F. May has been with the SAHS for over 10 years and stated that this building has been a dream of the staff, board and supporters for a long time and now it is finally becoming a reality.

“We wanted each of our supporters to truly be a part of the building and that is why a beam- central to the core of the building-was selected for signing,” May said. “Just like the beam, our donors and supporters are pivotal to the success of the San Antonio Humane Society.”

Individuals were able to go onto the construction grounds and sign one of the beams of the Leeu Naylor Medical Building. Many signed their name, pet’s names or an inspirational thought on the beam to leave their mark on the new building.


During the event, attendees were also able to mingle with adoptable pups and learn about foster and adoption opportunities.
