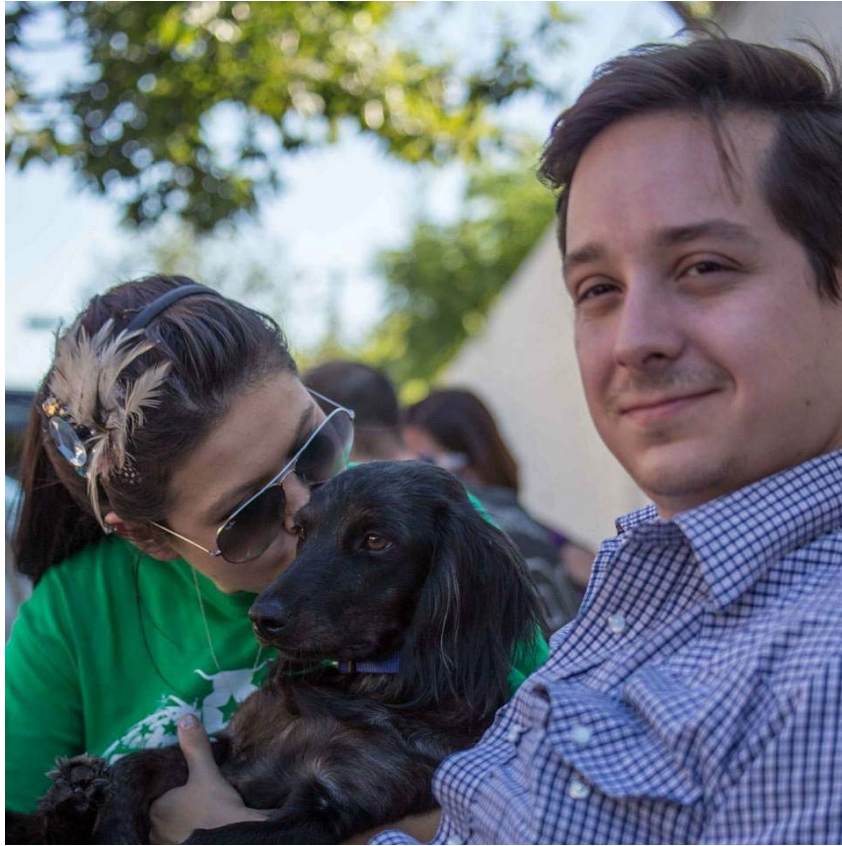


Pepper
