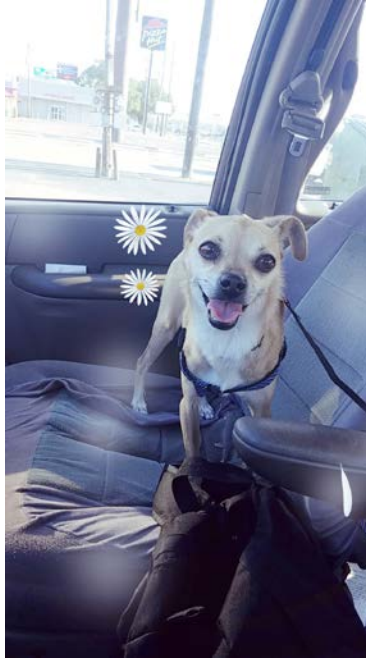


# Benjamin
