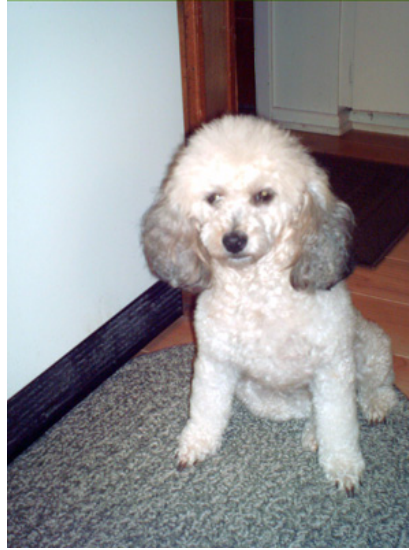


## Lola
