Transfer Dog Adoption Special at the San Antonio Humane Society

SAN ANTONIO, TX (September 10, 2013) – September 10th through September 20th, all dogs 1 year and older who have been transferred from Animal Care Services to the San Antonio Humane Society are available for adoption at the reduced adoption fee of \$25. This adoption fee includes: spay/neuter surgery, first set of vaccinations, microchip, de-wormer, flea and heartworm prevention, collar, tag, complimentary wellness exam within the first 5 days of adoption, 14 day complimentary follow up care at any VCA animal hospital, 30 days Sheltercare insurance, and a starter bag of Hill's Science Diet pet food.

To date, the San Antonio Humane Society has transferred 2,331 pets from Animal Care Services and helped them find new forever homes. The SAHS is on track to hit their goal of transferring 2,500 pets from Animal Care Services by September 30th. Since October of 2011, the San Antonio Humane Society and Animal Care Services have worked hand-in-hand to find homes for the abandoned dogs and cats of San Antonio as a part of the initiative to make San Antonio a no-kill city.
