Five-Week-Old Kitten Found In Dumpster

SA, TX (August 2, 2019) – Five-week-old kitten, weighing just over a pound, is now residing at the San Antonio Humane Society (SAHS) after being rescued from a dumpster by a good Samaritan Thursday afternoon.

The tiny bright-eyed kitten, now known as Oscar, was found only after his rescuer heard crying from a box inside the dumpster. Oscar was full of fleas and taken to the SAHS for care.

It was clear Oscar was starved for food and attention. After immediately scarfing down a can of food, the kitten was given flea medicine, affection, and a warm bed.

As a neonate, Oscar is scheduled to go into foster care for approximately 4-6 weeks before he's ready for adoption.



The SAHS wishes to remind the community to consider surrendering a pet to a shelter if they are unable to care for them. Receiving hours at the SAHS are Mondays and Fridays beginning at 10 a.m. on a first-come, first-served basis as space allows. Visit SAhumane.org/receiving for more information.
