San Antonio Humane Society to help transport approximately 100+ cats and dogs affected by Hurricane Ian

Who: San Antonio Humane Society (SAHS)

What: The San Antonio Humane Society is partnering with Florida animal shelters to help transport and receive approximately 75 dogs and 30 cats impacted by Hurricane Ian. The SAHS team will drive out and meet the Florida rescue team halfway in Orange, TX on Monday, Oct. 3, and they are expected to return between 8 p.m. to 10 p.m. (estimated time) that same day.

Time: Estimated between 8 p.m. - 10 p.m.

More: The SAHS is preparing to help transport shelter dogs and cats in Escambia County, Florida directly affected by Hurricane Ian. SAHS staff and volunteers are currently preparing kennel areas and assembling crates that will be used to transport the incoming pets. By assisting with this transport, the SAHS is hoping to give these dogs and cats a second chance at finding forever homes, while also freeing up much-needed space in the Florida shelters deeply affected by the hurricane.

"In moments like this, it is more important than ever that we come together and help our rescue partners in need," SAHS President/CEO Nancy F. May said. "We are proud to be a part of this lifesaving mission, and we look forward to helping these vulnerable animals find their homes across our community."

The dogs and cats will become available for adoption through the SAHS adoption process once they are cleared by veterinarians. If you would like to support SAHS's hurricane rescue efforts, the shelter is accepting monetary donations and supplies such as dog/cat beds, paper towels, canned chicken, kitten formula (KMR), blankets, towels, cleaning supplies (Lysol disinfecting wipes), treats, Feliway and Adaptil sprays, dog leashes, cat litter, toys, and wet canned pet food.
