SAN ANTONIO, TX (May 10 2021) – The San Antonio Humane Society (SAHS) announced today a \$35,000 grant investment from the newly named, Petco Love, to support their lifesaving work for animals in San Antonio and its surrounding areas.

“We are honored to be selected for Petco Love’s continued generosity in supporting lifesaving efforts in our community,” said Nancy F. May, CEO/President of SAHS. “This will aid us in providing even more opportunities for residents who are looking to improve the lives of their pets.”



In 2020, the SAHS was able to conduct more than 14,000 spay/neuter surgeries for San Antonio and its neighboring communities. In order to take advantage of low-cost spay/neuter surgeries and events offered by the SAHS, the nonprofit asks that individuals continue checking SAhumane.org/spayneuter.

Petco Love is a nonprofit leading change for pets nationally by harnessing the power of love to make communities and pet families closer, stronger, and healthier.
