SAN ANTONIO HUMANE SOCIETY PARTNERS WITH NORTH SHORE ANIMAL LEAGUE AMERICA FOR TOUR FOR LIFE® 2021, THE WORLD'S LARGEST NATIONAL COOPERATIVE PET ADOPTION EVENT

WHAT: **SAN ANTONIO HUMANE SOCIETY** is teaming up with **NORTH SHORE ANIMAL LEAGUE AMERICA** for **Tour For Life 2021** – the world's largest national cooperative, life-saving pet adoption event – in partnership with **Purina®**, for a week-long celebration at their shelter. From **Monday, March 29 through Saturday, April 3, adoption fees are 50 percent off all animals (this promotion excludes Ambassador pets.)** All approved adopters will receive a **free dose of flea protection** for their new pet. Additionally, approved adopters will receive **giveaways provided by Purina**, while supplies last.

The San Antonio Humane Society currently has a no contact adoption process in place with limited appointment opportunities to “meet and greet” the pets every day. Those interested in adopting an animal should:

- Visit www.SAhumane.org/adoption
- When you find the pet you're interested in adopting, click the button that says “Interested in this animal? Click here.” You'll then fill out an online application.
- Send an email to adoption@SAHumane.org (please include the name of the pet and ID# on the subject line and attach a government-issued ID and proof of residence to the email.)
- All the information will be evaluated on a first-come, first-served basis and adoption interviews will take place over the phone.
- Once approved, the San Antonio Humane Society staff will schedule a pick-up date and time to pick up the pet curbside at the shelter.

This year's events have been reimagined to accommodate COVID-19 health and safety protocols. Tour For Life remains committed to its mission of generating awareness of the plight of homeless animals. Tour For Life 2021 will run throughout March and April with weeklong events in **53 cities/towns in 37 states**, spotlighting local shelter partners/rescue groups dedicated to finding homes for the animals in their care.
