Abandoned Puppy under 1604 & 281

San Antonio, TX- On July 24th, a San Antonio resident found a puppy tied up to an electrical box under the intersection of 1604 & 281. Unable to leave a defenseless puppy out in the heat with no water or protection from the elements, Tristan stopped, picked up the puppy, and brought him to the San Antonio Humane Society.

"Sparkie" is about six weeks old and believed to be a terrier mix. He will remain in foster care until he is eight weeks old and ready for adoption. Other than a handful of ticks and fleas, the puppy appears to be in good condition.
