5,370 Pets Adopted in 2012 from San Antonio Humane Society

(Friday, January 4) In 2012, with the help of the community, the San Antonio Humane Society(SAHS) found new homes for 5,370 dogs and cats. As a non-profit, no-kill shelter, every adoption is celebrated as a victory for our city as San Antonio moves closer to its goal of becoming no-kill.

The SAHS has renewed their contract with Animal Care Services and plans on continuing to transfer as many dogs and cats from the city facility as possible. As 2013 begins, the SAHS is already planning adoption events, fundraisers, and community outreach and education events to help every dog and cat who enters our facility find a forever loving home.

The San Antonio Humane Society is a non-profit, no-kill organization that has served Bexar County and its surrounding areas since 1952. We are not affiliated with the Humane Society of the United States or the ASPCA. Every year, the San Antonio Humane Society shelters, medically treats, and rehabilitates more than 5,000 animals that have been injured, abused, or abandoned until they are ready for adoption.
