Brooks Pregnant Transfer 'Dolly' and Puppies Now Available for Adoption at the San Antonio Humane Society

(Thursday, May 30) San Antonio, TX On March 15, 2013 the San Antonio Humane Society transferred a pregnant Terrier mix named Dolly from the Animal Care Services Brooks Facility to the SAHS shelter. Three days later, after being thoroughly examined by our medical staff, Dolly went into foster care where her temporary family made sure she had everything she needed to have a comfortable delivery.

On March 27, Dolly gave birth to 7 perfect puppies. The puppies spent 6 weeks with mom until they were weaned and then additional 2 weeks in foster care following Dolly's return to the shelter.

While Dolly and her puppies once had an uncertain fate, now all will find loving homes, and soon! The 7 puppies will be available for adoption Friday, May 31st at 12pm noon at the San Antonio Humane Society, 4804 Fredericksburg Rd.
